Waste must fit in containers that do not exceed 5 gallons in volume.

- Pesticides and poisons
- Thermometers
- Thermostats
- Mercury and mercury-containing items
- Fluorescent lights/ballasts
- Polishes
- Household cleaners
- Pool chemicals
- Rust remover
- Solvents
- Degreasers
- Motor oil
- Antifreeze
- Engine and brake cleaner
- Transmission and brake fluid
- Paint and paint thinners
- Automotive/Marine paint
- Wood preservatives
- Kerosene/Gas
- Aerosols
- Batteries
- Arts and craft supplies
- Adhesives
- Photographic chemicals

What not to bring

- Radioactive waste
- Ammunition
- Asbestos
- Explosives
- Sharps
- Pharmaceuticals
- Electronic waste

Special COVID-19 instructions

- **Materials will not be collected from passenger compartments.** Place all materials in trunk, SUV cargo area or truck bed. If materials are not in these locations, you will be asked to leave the line and move the materials.
- Keep products in original containers when possible.
- Group items in boxes or sturdy containers - **NO PLASTIC BAGS.**
- No additional passengers, please.
- Wear your mask when approached by staff.
- Please follow the instructions on the signs at the event upon arrival.
